

# Annapolis Ten-Mile Run Has Banner Day

**O**n Sunday, August 30 the Annapolis Striders conducted the 17th Annapolis Ten-Mile Run. The runners were graced with great weather as the week-long heat and humidity broke. Sunday was cool and sunny as the competitors followed the course from the Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium through downtown Annapolis and the United States Naval Academy, over the Severn River, through shaded gently rolling suburban hills, and back across the river to finish on the grass in front of the stadium.

The 3,500 entrants represented 20 states. Proceeds of the event benefited the American Heart Association and community projects in Anne Arundel County. The run was supported by 450 race-day volunteers and by the generosity of both governmental and corporate sponsors. The principal sponsor is Katcef Brothers/Bud Light. The City of Annapolis joined the list of sponsors for 1992 demonstrating its support for amateur athletics.

Doug Mock of Bowie repeated his 1991 triumph as the Men's Open Champion in a time of 50:37 edging out former Annapolis Run champion Jerry Clapper of Columbia by 16 seconds. Nancy Beiger of Stockton, New Jersey, was the decisive Women's Open Champion finishing in 58:34. The Men's Masters Champion was Bennett Beach [55:47].

The emotional highlight of the race was the second place finish of Annapolis Strider Rose Malloy in 1:00:45. As the first female Anne Arundel County finisher, Rose received the Pat O'Brien Award given in memory of Pat who died suddenly in May of this year. The annual award was established by the Annapolis Striders to commemorate Pat O'Brien's

achievements in promoting long distance running.

Awards were made to each of the top three finishers in each age category. An exceptional performance was turned in by 13-year old Eric Post of Fairfax who finished in 1:06:44. The Baltimore RRC won the Men's Open Team competition and the Open Class Athletes won the women's championship. Men's and women's masters titles went to Gnats Masters and Fleet Feet McLean. Price Waterhouse took the corporate team award. Ken Archer won the wheelchair division in a time of 41:50.

Complete results appear in the October "Runner's Gazette" which will be distributed to all participants. The Race Director, Will Scott, performed admirably in coordinating the myriad of details which made the race so exceptional. A director and race committee members are being solicited now for the 18th Annapolis Run scheduled for Sunday, August 29, 1993.
