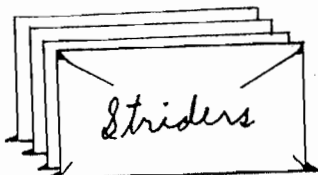

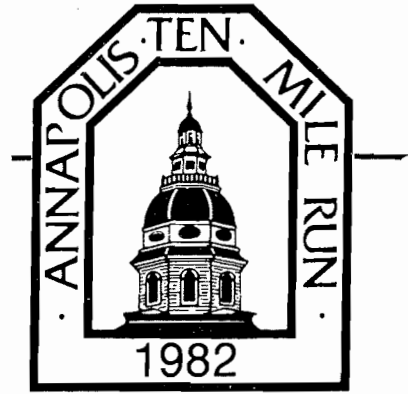
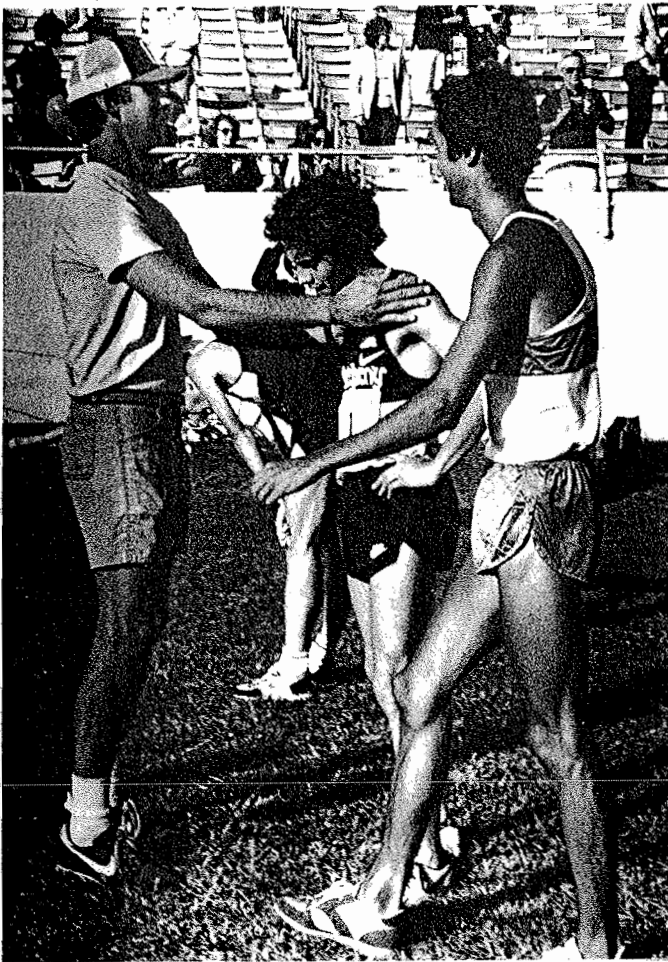
#### FINAL WORDS ON THE 7th ANNAPOLIS RUN
