We previously advised you that the federal enclave of the USNA and Naval Support Activity Annapolis (NSA Annapolis) was requiring that we not block the exit to Gate 8 of the USNA. This required us to change the course as previous discussed.

The club has been working hard over the past year to make this Annapolis 10 mile the best ever, and we all look forward to having you run in our town, enjoying Rowe Blvd (the gateway to Annapolis), Main Street, the hills of Pendennis Mount and traversing the Naval Academy Bridge twice. We can promise you lots of hills, heat, humidity, and after picking up your finishers award, a great after race celebration, including the traditional watermelon, beer and the sounds of the Dana B All Star Band.
